

The Walls Around Us Student Competition

Conditions of Entry:

Eligibility:

The Walls Around Us Student Competition is open Australia wide to students enrolled in an architecture course in the 2022 year. Both undergraduate and masters students are eligible to enter.

Entries may be submitted by individual Applicants only. The Applicant may submit one Entry only.

The Applicant must be 18 years of age or over at the date of entry. The Applicant must possess the legal right to work in Australia.

Employees and relatives of the Organisers (Robin Boyd Foundation) or Judges are ineligible to enter.

In order to be eligible, the Applicant must submit their Entry via the online form by 4.00 pm AEST Monday 30th January 2023.
